ClubGRANTS is one of Australia's largest grant programs, providing more than \$100 million in cash each year to a variety of worthy causes across NSW. Charities, sporting organisations and not-for-profit community groups are among tens-of-thousands of worthy causes funded through the program each year.

Central Coast Leagues Club has funded seven worthy causes within the Gosford region during the first half of the ClubGRANTS year 20-21 and has also supplied in-kind room hire to numerous organisations.

Women's Justice Network	This project will support the recruitment, screening, and training of volunteers to become mentors of women and girls returning to the Central Coast after being incarcerated, providing women with an opportunity to learn coping mechanisms, new skills, confidence, and direction to assist them in overcoming various issues, allowing them to become contributing members of the community and avoid incarceration.	\$5,000.00
Cerebral Palsy Alliance	This project will support the fit out of the fully accessible gym, providing specialist equipment to support the health and well-being of children, teens, and adults with disability on the Central Coast.	\$21,337.00
Surf Life Saving Central Coast Inc	This project will support the volunteers with reliable equipment that can be deployed in an emergency, such as a rescue water craft (jet ski). CCLC has also supplied funding for uniforms, training equipment, secure storage cabinets and electrical work for the SLSCC radio communications system.	\$45,000.00
